Key Texts	The Enormous Turnip, Jasper's Beanstalk and Jack & the Beanstalk (Fiction) 'Sunflowers' and 'Seeds' (Non-Fiction)
Learning Challenges	Where do seeds come from? What do plants need to grow? How do we care for plants? How do animals grow and develop? How do we change from babies as we grow?
